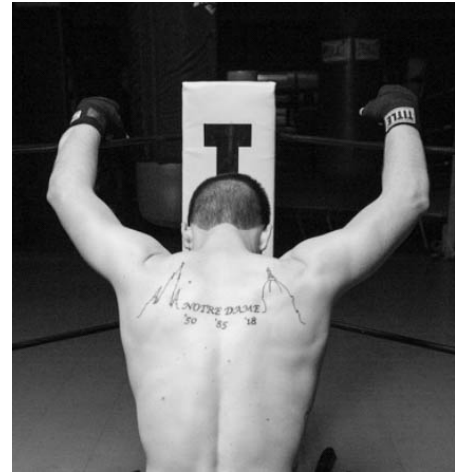

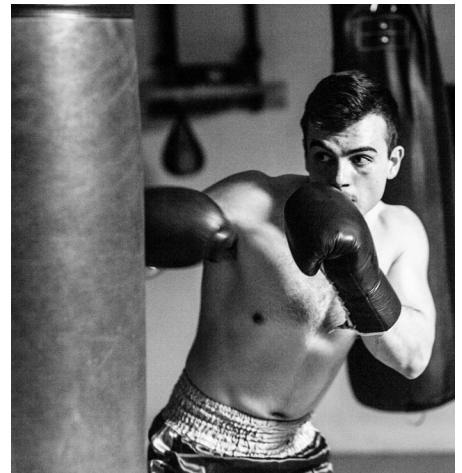

MICHAEL KRECEK ■ MORRISSEY HALL

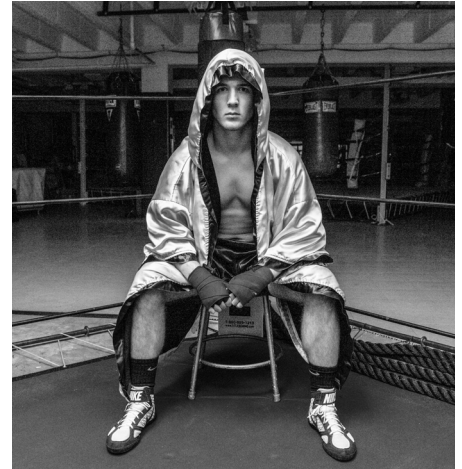

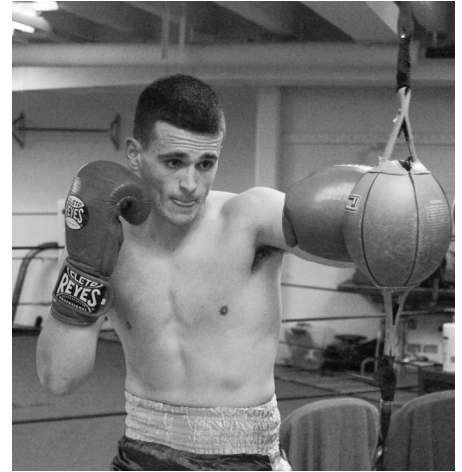

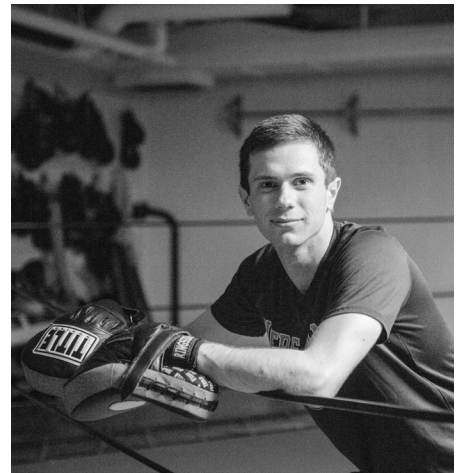

LETTER WRITTEN FROM DAMON AFFINITO, CLASS OF '97 TO BENGAL BOUTS BOXING MANAGER

Simply put, Bengal Bouts are awesome! They represent everything that Notre Dame is about - faith, charity, fraternity, and a quest for excellence. I'm so thankful that they were a part of my Notre Dame experience. Looking back to my time as a student, I now realize that I wasn't as focused on the charitable aspect of the Bouts as I should have been. I was so caught up in competing and winning that I sometimes I failed to see the bigger picture. It wasn't until after I graduated that I fully realized the importance of the Bouts' role in supporting the missions.

I was also fortunate to be surrounded by so many great people during my time in the Boxing Room. In addition to my teammates, some of the coaches and trainers were among the best people I met in my four years on campus. I'm not sure how many are still involved, but Pat Farrell, Terry Johnson, Fr. Bill Seetch, Sweet C., and Tom Suddes (I know he sadly passed away) are among the finest people Notre Dame has to offer. And, of course, there was Jack Mooney. I'm not sure if you've heard of him (he passed away at least ten years ago.), but he was a throwback to Rockne-era Notre Dame. He was one of our trainers - old-school all the way. He was like Mickey from the "Rocky" movies. He was also the self-appointed caretaker of Knute Rockne's grave. I remember taking a ride to the cemetery with him one time.

So many great memories. The Bouts truly served as a vital part of my life. I learned - and continue to learn - so many important lessons through my affiliation with the boxing program. In that light, I'd like to thank you for your service. The Bouts can not accomplish their goals without student managers like yourself who dedicate their time to the cause. You and your fellow managers are just as important to the Bouts - and maybe even more so - than the boxers. Like you, I took part in the Bouts all four of my years. I hope they remain as special a memory to you as they are to me.

BANGLADESH REFLECTIONS

CHRIS LEMBO ■ STANFORD HALL

Spending two months in Bangladesh allowed me the opportunity to see the direct impact of the Bengal Bouts fundraising. The Holy Cross Fathers and Brothers in Bangladesh are scattered throughout the remote village areas of the country, where families often live dozens of miles away from any health clinic, education system, food market, or substantial employment. Most of the people residing in these villages are unable to provide the basic needs for their families on a daily basis due to this isolation, but also because of their Catholic beliefs and commitment to their tribal culture and language. The Holy Cross Mission intervenes to set up primary, secondary, and technical schools to assist these groups of people who are so often discriminated against, even by their own government. The Bengal Bouts funds help to set up hostels for the boys and girls of these families to live in while they attend classes run by the priests and Brothers. In Bangladesh, I had the chance to live on the school grounds and teach these kids during the day. Teaching the boys and girls was without a doubt the most joyous and fulfilling activity I have ever done. During class, I taught basic English grammar, which almost always ended up turning into playing games, singing songs, and dancing. Regardless of how much English was learned, each class finished with some boxing instruction, and the boys and girls had the chance to come up to the front of the class, put on the gloves, and whack the mits as hard as they wished. Most of my days in the country I spent like this, building deeper relationships with the 7th, 8th, and 9th grade boys and girls of Sreemangal.

Bengal Bouts funds have certainly made a difference in helping the Holy Cross Mission provide these services to the villages living in poverty, but there is still work to be done. Thousands of kids still have no means of accessing education and healthcare. As we are all fighting for the same humanity, there is reason to care for and live in solidarity with those living halfway across the globe.

Tim and I had the unique experience of serving with Holy Cross in Jalchatra, Bangladesh. We were strangers to a new culture, to unfamiliar faces, and to a traffic system whose rules were taken as light suggestions. Despite all of this, we fell in love as soon as we took our first steps out of the airport. From the warm and earthy air, to the enthusiastic "hello" of the priests, we were welcomed with open arms and affectionate smiles. The feeling of being a stranger quickly disappeared as the students, teachers, and religious reminded us of our familial bond in the way that they loved and shared their culture with us. Jalchatra is one of many locations where Holy Cross has set up parishes, schools, and clinics for the indigenous, tribal people of Bangladesh. Where government has failed to protect the rights and land of their indigenous people, Holy Cross has stepped in to provide the basic amenities for nourishing the body, mind, and spirit. Where the tribal people are pushed to the margins of society and ignored by political legislation, Holy Cross has given them a voice. Yet, there is still work to be done. Bengal Bouts continues to support Holy Cross and the indigenous people in many ways. As we continue training, let's remember the people of Bangladesh and the overwhelming support that they give to us. Let's remember that "strong bodies fight, that weak bodies may be nourished."

STANDING AWARDS & TROPHIES

Each year the Notre Dame Bengal Bouts gives special awards, many of which are named in honor of those who have contributed so much to the Bouts and to the Holy Cross Missions in Bangladesh. The following are short descriptions of the Standing Awards of the Bengal Bouts.

BENGAL BOUTS AWARD - SWEET C ROBINSON

The Bengal Bouts Award has been given annually since 1950 to the person who has "given the most for amateur and intercollegiate sport." Presented at Finals Night, the Bengal Bouts Award is the most prestigious of all the program's awards. Recipients have included Bishop Bernie Shiel, founder of the CYO, Fr. Tom Brennan, C.S.C., Tony Zale, Rich O'Leary, Fr. Ned Joyce, C.S.C. and Pulitzer Prize Winner, George Dohrmann to name a few.

RICH O'LEARY AWARD - RON GRISOLI

For over 37 years, Rich O'Leary served the students of Notre Dame. He coached the men's lacrosse team for 18 seasons before becoming Director of RecSports, where his guiding influence protected the place of amateur boxing and non-varsity sport at Notre Dame for nearly four decades. In honor of our "Coach for All Seasons", whose unique gifts and quiet leadership have served the Notre Dame Bengal Bouts, the Rich O'Leary Award is given annually to an individual who selflessly works behind the scenes for the benefit of the Tournament.

BEST NOVICE BOXER AWARD

The Best Novice Boxer Award is given to the best first year boxer- sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student.

BILL MCCARTHY "OFF THE ROPES" AWARD

Awarded to the boxer who has "come back from adversity." George McCarthy was a Notre Dame grad who became sports editor of the South Bend Tribune. His support and journalistic coverage of the Bengal Bouts was legendary. George particularly admired those boxers who have come back to compete from personal or physical adversity; and asked that a trophy be instituted for such a competitor.

BILL SEETCH AWARD

As the Bengal Bouts participation has grown from 50 to 60 boxers 40 or 50 years ago, to over 200 boxers over the last 6 years, a preliminary round was added before the quarterfinals. Bill Seetch, a 1974 graduate of ND, and an accomplished rugby player during his undergraduate days, served as the Bengal Bouts chaplain for over 20 years. In the spirit of Fr. Tuffy Ryan, an award was added in Bill's name to the best boxer not to advance from the Preliminaries.

DAN ADAM AWARD

Dan Adam was an accomplished athlete from Harvard during his undergraduate days. While in Law School at Notre Dame, Dan competed in the Bengal Bouts, and was known for his willingness to help others, and his excellence in the ring. Dan died shortly after his graduation from Law School from an unknown heart condition. On the Saturday morning before every first home game, Dan's law school friends attend a special award ceremony where the name of the best boxer from the Law School is added to the special plaque hanging in the Law School in Dan's name.

DENNIS CLARK AWARD

The Dennis Clark Award is given to the best Freshman boxer. Dennis was an outstanding boxer and officer of the Notre Dame Boxing Club. Following his graduation, Dennis took a job with IBM in Chicago. Though Dennis died in his early 20s from a car accident, he left a financial legacy to Notre Dame in his estate. The Clark family donated this standing trophy in his honor.

FR. TOM BRENNAN, C.S.C. SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

Given to the Senior boxer, usually a non-officer, who has exemplified great sportsmanship during training and during the tournament. Fr. Tom Brennan, C.S.C. was the longstanding chaplain of the Bengal Bouts during the 1940's, 50's, 60's, and 70's. A university handball champion, Fr. Brennan was also a close friend of Nappy's.

FR. 'TUFFY' RYAN, C.S.C. AWARD

Fr. James 'Tuffy' Ryan was a well-known and memorable figure on campus from the 1930's to the 1950's. He would lead hiking expeditions (with walking canes and all) from his residence at Walsh Hall. Fr. Ryan was a great supporter of the Bengal Bouts for its competitive and character building qualities. Fr. Ryan was particularly supportive to those competitors who did not advance in the tournament, indicating to them that they were champions to the underprivileged in Bangladesh just for stepping in the ring. When Fr. Ryan died in the 1950's, his student friends instituted a standing trophy in his name for the best boxer not to advance from the Quarterfinals.

STANDING AWARDS & TROPHIES

GEORGE DOHRMANN AWARD

The George Dohrmann Award is given to the best student journalist, in print or photo, who assists through their excellence in covering the Bengal Bouts. George won a Pulitzer shortly after his graduation from Notre Dame for investigative reporting of an academic scandal involving athletes at a Big Ten university. He later became an investigative reporter for Sports Illustrated. But George is best known to the Bengal Bouts for his professional coverage of the Bouts during his four years on the sports desk of the Observer. By his senior year, George revolutionized the campus coverage of the Bengal Bouts by adding a 4-page, full color spread pull out of the student paper, individually covering each match of the Finals. At the time, only varsity football had ever received such coverage. In recognition of such excellence, the first annual George Dohrmann Award was awarded to George himself at the Bengal Bouts banquet his senior year.

JACK MOONEY AWARD

Awarded to the most improved boxer, whether he won or lost. Jack Mooney was an accomplished amateur boxer from South Bend, who grew up selling newspapers at the train station to individuals, including Knute Rockne. Jack helped Nappy and the Bengal Bouts for over 50 years. In his mid-80's, he still had the spirit of a 20-year-old, and connected with all the young Bengal Boxers. Ever rooting for the underdog, this standing award is given each year in Jack's name.

LARRY ASH AWARD

The Larry Ash Award is given to the best boxer of the tournament. Larry Ash attended Notre Dame in the early 1950's and was a light-heavyweight champ. He died tragically in an Air Force plane accident. His friends and family got together to construct a most stunning trophy that is usually on display at the RecSports office. The Larry Ash Trophy is traditionally brought into the ring at the end of the last championship match, and awarded to the Best Boxer of the Tournament.

NAPPY AWARD

Given to the President of the Boxing Club who acts as "Head Captain" of the Boxing team. Dominic "Nappy" Napolitano '32 '33 served as the director of the Boxing Program for over 50 years. His motto from the 1930's, "Strong bodies fight that weak bodies may be nourished," survives as our goal today.

SHAWN NEWBURG AWARD

The Shawn Newburg Award is given to the best boxer in the Bengal Bouts from the military. Shawn was a Boxing Club President and Captain and was an officer in the U.S. Navy serving on a nuclear submarine. Only 4 years out of Notre Dame, Shawn was tragically killed in a car accident in 2006 on his way home from the naval base. Shawn's wife, Amy, donated funds to the University establishing a scholarship in Shawn's name.

TOM SUDDER LEGACY AWARD

This award is given to the boxer who raised the most money for the Holy Cross Missions in Bangladesh. This award is made possible through the generosity of the Boilchini family. This award is symbolized by a pair of boxing boots given to Coach Sudder by the founder of Bengal Bouts, Dominic "Nappy" Napolitano. This award is the most recent award created and has only been awarded once.

ABOUT BENGAL BOUTS PROCEEDS

The Priests, Brothers, and Sisters work tirelessly to provide these tribal peoples with the tools to fight back against poverty and injustice by equipping them with an education. A little goes a long way in Bangladesh.

- \$100 will pay for the training of a teacher for one year
- \$50 is enough to pay the salary of a teacher for a month
- \$150 will pay for a boarding student to live and eat at the parish for a year while receiving an education
- \$500 is equivalent to the cost of running one fully serviced medical center for one year
